**TO : ALL CONCERNED**

**RE: Clarification on Outdoor Exercise vis-a-vis Use of Common Spaces and Safe Zones**

---

To properly implement the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) Resolution No. 38, Series of 2020, as well as the provisions of Taguig City Executive Order No. 7, Series of 2020 and the Taguig Safe City Task Force Advisories, the following clarificatory guidelines must be observed:

1. All individuals are allowed to go out to exercise, provided they can observe a social distance of five (5) meters;
2. Since small children require the close supervision of their parents or guardians and cannot be expected to follow social distancing protocols, the City Government has mandated barangay captains, purok or area leaders, and heads of homeowners' associations to designate Safe Zones in all barangays and private residential establishments for the use of their residents.
3. Safe Zones are highly regulated areas where the health and safety of its users are closely monitored. In accordance with Safe City Task Force Advisory No. 6, Safe Zones are now defined as a specific area and/or specific time in common areas that will be for the exclusive use of Senior Citizens, children, pregnant women and those with comorbidities.
4. The City Government highly encourages all residents of Taguig to utilize these spaces for their own safety. However, loitering, mingling and congregating is still strictly prohibited.
5. Law enforcement units are hereby advised to proceed in accordance with these guidelines.

Any person in violation of these guidelines shall be penalized in accordance with Republic Act No. 11469, otherwise known as the "Bayanihan We Heal As One Act," Republic Act No. 11332, otherwise known as the "Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act" in relation to Presidential Proclamation No. 922, and other applicable laws and ordinances. This will be without prejudice to the filing of an administrative case if the violator is a government official or employee.
