TO : ALL RESIDENTS, EMPLOYEES, EMPLOYERS AND OWNERS OF BUSINESSESTABLISHMENTS, OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF GOVERNMENT OFFICES, AND OTHER STAKEHOLDERS OF THE CITY OF TAGUIG

RE: Rules on the Use of Motorcycles, Bicycles, including Electronic Bikes (e-Bikes) during the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ)

To properly implement the Guidelines of the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) on allowing the use of private motorcycles and bicycles, including e-Bikes, as a means of transportation during the MECQ, the following guidelines shall be followed:

1. Individuals reporting to work, or those allowed to go out of their homes to purchase essential supplies and/or goods shall be allowed to use motorcycles and bicycles, including e-Bikes, as their means of transportation;
2. Only one (1) occupant is allowed in all motorcycles, bicycles and e-Bikes. Back riders are strictly prohibited;
3. In addition to face masks, all drivers or riders must wear helmets and other protective gear; and
4. All drivers and riders must present their Taguig City Unified Quarantine Pass, Company ID and/or Certificate of Employment (CoE) upon inspection or at all designated checkpoints. However, if the drivers or riders are essential worker/s, they may present their Company ID and/or Certificate of Employment (CoE) only. Individuals caught without the documents mentioned shall be sent home immediately and reported to the Barangay for proper monitoring.

Any person in violation of this guidelines shall be penalized in accordance with Republic Act No. 11469 otherwise known as "Bayanihan We Heal as One Act", Republic Act No. 11332 otherwise known as "Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act" in relation to Presidential Proclamation No. 922 and other applicable laws and ordinances. This will be without prejudice to the filing of administrative case if the violator is a government official or employee.
