

MECQ TO GIVE MEDICAL FRONTLINERS TIMEOUT



Heeding the call of medical workers for a timeout, Taguig City and the rest of Metro Manila will transition into the modified enhanced community quarantine at **12 midnight** on **Tuesday**. Past MECQ rules will apply with some modifications. The MECQ will mean the temporary closure of some businesses, with the specifics to be released within the day.

In a show of solidarity to medical frontliners and in response to the President Duterte's call, some establishments in Taguig have **signified to VOLUNTARILY CLOSE** and offer work-from-home arrangements for **14 days or two weeks**. Businesses offering essentials goods and services will remain open.
