



# CLARIFICATIONS ON CERTAIN ACTIVITIES AND BUSINESSES ALLOWED TO OPERATE DURING THE GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (GCQ)

In accordance with the **Transition Protocols in Metro Manila of the National Task Force Against COVID-19 (NTF)**, we seek to **clarify to all Taguigeños and its stakeholders certain activities** during the **General Community Quarantine** starting 19 August 2020.

## MANDATORY WEARING OF FACE MASKS AND FACE SHIELDS

Face shields, apart from face masks (without vents), are also required to be worn inside all modes of public transportation, in indoor workplaces, and in all commercial places.



## MASS GATHERINGS

All mass gatherings, including religious activities, shall be limited to a maximum of ten (10) persons.



## BARBERSHOPS AND SALONS

Salons and Barbershops are allowed to operate at fifty percent (50%) operating capacity.

They are allowed to offer all hair, nail, and skin care services, **except full body massage**, but are subject to **further strict protocols** on hand sanitation, face mask and face shields, gloves, and sterilized equipment.

All other establishments offering **personal care services** or **aesthetic procedures** are not allowed to operate.



## DINE-IN OPERATIONS

All restaurants and fast food establishments are allowed to resume dine-in operations at **thirty percent (30%)** operational and seating capacity.



## MOTORCYCLE BACK RIDING

According to the NTF on motorcycle back riding, **only if both riders** are living in the same house, there is no need for a motorcycle barrier.

The backrider must be an **Authorized Person Outside Residence (APOR)**, while the driver may or may not be an APOR. The motorcycle must be privately owned and **not for hire**, and **both riders must wear face masks and full-face helmets at all times.**
