TO : ALL CONCERNED

RE: Placement of a Worker's Quarters of a Business Establishment in Barangay Palingon under Localized Community Quarantine (LCQ)

Using the latest data from the Systematic Mass Approach on Responsible Testing (SMART) program implemented in the City and the Protocols for Employee Testing in Safe City Advisory No. 5, our analysis of the results of the RT-PCR tests, active case finding and extensive contact tracing conducted in a business establishment in Barangay Palingon have shown a cluster of infections of COVID-19 cases from their workers' quarters. In order to further isolate and contain the virus, the City Epidemiology and Disease Surveillance Unit (CEDSU) and the Quarantine and Containment Management Team (QCMT) recommended the following:

1. Restrict the movement of the employees staying at the workers' quarters;
2. Ensure delivery of the needed social and economic services to those staying in the quarters; and,
3. Conduct further testing and active case finding at the identified localized area.

Hence, based on the data of CEDSU and the recommendation of the QCMT, **starting 19 August 2020 until 2 September 2020**, the Workers' Quarters of a business establishment located in Barangay Palingon **shall be placed under Localized Community Quarantine (LCQ)**.

The rules and guidelines in accordance with the provisions Taguig Safe City Task Force Advisory No. 12 shall be implemented in the abovementioned areas.

Any person found in violation of these guidelines shall be penalized in accordance with Republic Act No. 11332, otherwise known as the "Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act" in relation to Presidential Proclamation No. 922, and other applicable laws and ordinances. This will be without prejudice to the filing of an administrative case if the violator is a government official or employee.
