RE: **Lifting of Localized Community Quarantine (LCQ) and Continuous Observation and Monitoring of Certain Areas in Barangay Sta. Ana**

This memorandum is in relation to the report forwarded to our office by our Taguig City Epidemiology and Disease Surveillance Unit (CEDSU) dated 30 September 2020 regarding the clustering of cases in a certain areas in Barangay Sta. Ana

We quote the findings of our CEDSU in their report, which states:

“Upon validation of case with the Sta Ana Health Center, a total of 63 confirmed CoVID-19 cases were reported from August 1-30, 2020 in the LCQ areas. Random sample testing was done on September 21-24, 2020 with a total of 623 individuals swabbed. Initial 517 results showed 19 (3.7%) were confirmed cases. This is an incidence of 2.38 per 10,000 population. Analysis of the change rate in cases from the LCQ areas showed a 47% decrease in cases during the LCQ (Table 1).

There was a decrease in confirmed covid-19 incidence from 3.32 to 2.38 per 10,000 population. 2. There was a 47% decrease in cases during the LCQ period.”

As cited from the report, CEDSU recommends the Local Quarantine be lifted and continuous observation of minimum health standards must be done in the area. It is further recommended:

1. To continue daily disease surveillance of cases
2. To continue observing the minimum health standards
3. To continue health promotion and educational activities vs CoVID-19.
