

# STATEMENT OF THE SAFE CITY TASK FORCE ON THE CITY OF TAGUIG'S "ROAD TO ZERO" CAMPAIGN IN RESPONSE TO THE RECENT UPWARD TREND OF CASES IN NCR

Today, 8 March 2021, in a meeting of the Safe City Task Force with the Executive Council, composed of the City Mayor, the City Administrator, key department heads, and representatives of the Sanggunian Panlungsod, the Association of Barangay Captains, and the Sanggunian Kabataan Federation, the Mayor has ordered a review and enhancement of the following:

- 1. Strengthen the implementation** of the “New Normal Ordinance of Taguig City” (City Ordinance No. 24, Series of 2020) as we responsibly reopen the economy while effectively flattening the curve;
- 2. Continue to capacitate all business establishments** as key partners of the the LGU to ensure the safety and well-being of all its workers and patrons as we transition to the New Normal;
- 3. Encourage all citizens going to and coming from Taguig to avail of the City’s free RT-PCR Testing;**
- 4. Highly discourage household gatherings** to eradicate community-based transmissions; and,
- 5. Roll out improved programs** committed to protect senior citizens, pregnant women, persons with disabilities, and other individuals with comorbidities

The support and cooperation of all Taguigeños, the private and business sectors and other stakeholders of the City is key in achieving our goal for the Road to Zero campaign.
