

# GUIDELINES ON THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF LIQUOR AND OTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES



In accordance with Safe City Task Force Advisory No. 36

- 1** Only establishments with the appropriate liquor license shall be allowed to sell or serve alcoholic beverages. Those caught selling or serving liquor without the required licenses shall be closed down immediately.
- 2** Customers of eating establishments allowed to serve liquor are only allowed a maximum of two (2) individual servings of any alcoholic beverage (Sec. 3, DTI MC No. 20-39).
- 3** Consumption of alcohol in bulk (pitchers, buckets, unlimited promos) is strictly prohibited.
- 4** Purchase of alcoholic beverages from convenience stores, groceries and other similar retail stores shall continue to be allowed. However, its consumption within their premises is strictly prohibited.

To ensure the safety and health of everyone, all restaurant and convenience store owners and managers are reminded to properly implement the guidelines discussed above, and patrons who refuse to comply must be asked to immediately leave their premises.
